AutoXotic Showcased at University of South Florida's 4th annual HospitaBull Evening

April 16, 2014 marked University of South Florida's 4th annual HospitaBull Evening at the Lakewood Ranch Polo Grill. Guests of the event were greeted by USF hospitality students, along with a selection of stunning cars from the AutoXotic fleet. This year's event, chaired by Michael Klauber and John Horne, was sold-out and is expected to have raised close to \$60k for the University. Funds raised from the event will go directly to the school and will help send USF hospitality students to trade shows around the world.
